Suggestions...

- Helping non SEND children to understand and accept the reasonable adjustments being made for those children and why
- More extra curricular activities are needed at the school. After school club could be utilised for a lot more clubs and activities, such as garden, baking, crafts.
- An end of term parents evening would be beneficial
